

# National Schools' Regatta 2025

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May 23rd - 25<sup>th</sup> 2025

## **INFORMATION FOR COACHES – trailers, minibuses, boat racks and cycling**

### **TRAILERS**

These should be parked on the grass bank on the score board (North) side of the course, with an overspill being the first grass car park beside the River Trent. Please enter the site using the first entrance off Adbolton Lane (<https://w3w.co/moral.ropes.robe>) and follow the instruction of the marshals.

Please note – This entrance will be manned from 1200 noon on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup>. We do not envisage any trailers arriving before that time. If, for any reason, you need earlier entry note that you will be charged for parking/entering due to the ANPR camera system on the site. Failure to pay will result in a fine from the car park operator.

NSR has arranged that the cameras for the trailer park will be switched off from 1200 on Thursday and remain off for the duration of the regatta. All trailers should be removed from the area by Sunday night.

### **REST AREA GAZEBOS**

Clubs and schools will be able to erect a small gazebo/marquee on the North bank for competitors and coaches to use during the regatta. These should be towards the top of the banking, towards the trees and the scoreboard so as to keep the trailer and boat area clear. A site map is available on the NSR website.

Please note that all Spectator Marquees are situated on the South side of the grass areas beside the Lake.

### **COMPETITOR COACHES and MINIBUSES**

Coach and minibus parking for competitors is on the North side of the course and vehicles should enter via the first entrance to the site off Adbolton Lane (<https://w3w.co/moral.ropes.robe>). There are two car parks along that road. Please follow the marshal's instructions. There will be no parking charges in this area for minibuses and competitor coaches for the duration of the regatta.

### **BOAT RACKS**

There will be **NO BOAT RACKS** beside the in/out pontoons or along the wall towards the centre buildings. We are operating a one-way system for boating and disembarking. Please follow the instructions from the marshals and read the boating instructions carefully.

### **CYCLING**

Although we have hired the site, there is still public access to the venue and as such, all cyclists must be aware, alert and considerate. Safety is paramount. Coaches bike permits can, as usual, be collected from the Raft Marshal's office – two only per club. This is to limit the numbers following each race. Do not abuse this privilege. Cycling will be on the North side only and will be diverted away from the path for the final 200m for safety.

**We strongly recommend that helmets be worn when cycling.**

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## MARQUEE SET-UP

The site will be open from 10:00 am Thursday morning (22<sup>nd</sup>) for erection of spectator marquees. All those setting up should check in at reception at the NWSC to give a note of the vehicle registration so as to access the marquee area and avoid a parking fine through the ANPR system. Please check your pitch number and location with Ben Mason and his team before setting up. They will be on site.
